This was an appeal for 22 daily wage earning families (including 9 children under 5 and 20, over 5), from Udumulla, a rural village in the Kalutara district. These people work as domestics, office assistants and mason's assistants, and are now deprived of work due to the pandemic; as people are reluctant to have workers from outside working in their homes. They are therefore struggling to survive.

We provided each family with a pack of dry rations, amounting to Rs. 2,000 per pack, which we believe would be able adequate for 1.5 to 2 weeks. The pack consisted of dry rations such as rice, dhal, cooking oil, soya, soap, tea, sugar, milk powder and biscuits for the children.
