AIM.

Cerebral palsy (CP) is a condition where a baby's developing brain is damaged, giving rise to abnormal posture and movement. This causes 'motor delays' in the child such as a delay in learning to sit, stand, walk and even play. The first step of the rehabilitation programme requires a special chair - the CP Chair; to develop correct posture and balance in a child with Cerebral Palsy.

RESULT.

With your generosity, sufficient funds were gathered to deliver two chairs to 6 year old Sujith and 8 year old Ashen. Having lived in Udagama, Kochchikade, Ashen Fernandopullei lost his father and is raised solely by his mother, who works as a labourer. Sujith Nilanga, one of four siblings, is the son of a housewife and farmer who hail from Urapotha, Bingiriya.
